Fee Structure

2009-2010

The EIU teams have two types of fees categories, club fees and team fees. Club fees are applied to all players and are paid to the club that is taking your team for the 2009-2010 season. Team fees are unique to each individual team and are paid to your team treasurer.

EIU 2009-2010 FEES

All fees discussed below should be paid to the club that your EIU team has been assigned to for the 2009-2010 Season. Try-out fee is due at tryouts, and the registration fee is due by June 30. Remaining team fees must be paid to the club responsible for your EIU team by September 1, 2009.

1. Registration Fee: \$100

Explanation: Each club will collect a registration fee from all EIU players registered through their club. This fee covers the expenses the club incurs when registering each player with state and national soccer associations. The fee also covers the various overhead administrative activities that EIU asks each feeder soccer club to undertake on behalf of their assigned EIU teams. These costs include the expenses incurred from the following sources: accounting services, office and administrative expenses, including phone, fax, postage, liability insurance, and internet services.

2. Coaching Fee

Explanation: The Blue team coaching fee will cover a minimum of 72 professionally run training sessions: 40 Fall, 20 Winter, and 12 Summer sessions. The Silver coaching fee will cover a minimum of 54 professionally run training sessions: 28 Fall, 20 Winter, and 6 Summer sessions. All coaching fees cover game coverage for ALL outdoor league and tournament games. You will not pay extra coaching fees for coaches to attend tournament games. However, your team will be responsible to cover your team's pro rate share of travel expenses for your EIU coach. This is outlined in the "Team Fees" section of this document. If a Silver player wants to train 3 sessions per week in the Fall, the extra session is \$75 per player, which sessions are to be arranged with your coach's permission.

3. Facility Fee

Explanation: Each club will collect a facility fee from all players on their EIU team. All of the money collected for facility fees are allocated to cover the expenses related to renting and/or maintaining outdoor and indoor practice fields in order to reserve field space for your team's practices for the 2009-2010 season.

TEAM FEES

To be sent to your team treasurer/manager.

Team fees are unique to each team and set by your team manager and/or treasurer.

1. Tournament Entry Fees
2. League Fees for IPSL
3. Coaching Reimbursement (see explanation below)

EIU Coaching Reimbursement Policy:

All EIU teams will reimburse their assigned EIU coach for tournaments and travel league games directly from the EIU team checking account. In the case of a tournament, only those players that attend the event are required to pay the coaching reimbursement expense. Only league games outside of the Iowa City and Cedar Rapids corridor are subject to reimbursement. All rostered players are responsible to pay their share of reimbursable league travel expenses. Listed below are the travel expenses that an EIU team must pay when an EIU coach covers a tournament or league travel game. If one EIU coach covers multiple EIU teams at a tournament or league game, then travel costs should be paid on a pro rata share between EIU teams.

EIU Coaching Staff Tournament Reimbursement

- 1) Mileage: \$.0.50 Per Mile
- 2) Meals:

Fridays or Travel Days to an Event: \$20 (if necessary)
All other Days: \$30 Per Day

3) Hotel Expense

The EIU team is responsible to reimburse the coach for all three categories described above. If the coach also works with another team from his/her club at the same event, they will not submit the full reimbursement expense to the EIU Team. EIU coaches WILL NOT submit these expenses to your team if the tournament is held in Iowa City or Cedar Rapids.

EIU Coaching Staff IPSL League Game Reimbursement

- 1) Mileage: \$.0.50 Per Mile
- 2) Meals: \$10 Total for the Day

EIU coaches WILL NOT submit these expenses to your team if the league game is held in Iowa City or Cedar Rapids.
